

Stakeholder Survey Methodology

The institution collects feedback from its stakeholders to evaluate and monitor and evaluate its performance quality on issues related to the curriculum and ambiance of the Institution. The feedback forms were collected from students, teachers, employers, alumnae, and professionals. The following are the different areas targeted for various stakeholders.

- Issues related to the Teaching and learning process, issues related to curriculum and institute ambiance issues in terms of quality, and skills are collected in student feedback form.
- Issues like course suitability and its need base, curriculum/course outcomes, course content, reference material, its availability are addressed in faculty feedback.
- Issues related to students' real-life problem-solving skills, communication skills, teamwork, other skills, and college ambiance are addressed in the Employer feedback form.
- Course curriculum, Syllabus sufficiency, and curriculum design are addressed in Alumni feedback.

The Academic Audit Committee designs and collects feedback from its stakeholders to monitor and evaluate its performance curriculum and college ambience-related issues. The feedback also considers issues like the delivery of curriculum by teachers.

The report of feedback analysis is submitted to the Principal, Core committee, concerned heads, and BOS for necessary action.

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Benchmark for Enhancing Student Experience: Summary of Action Thresholds (2018-19)

Action benchmark: 80% satisfaction (Choice of a rating at 'Satisfactory' or higher, or achieving a score of 4 or above on a scale ranging from 1 to 10).

The institution aims to have a significant majority (at least 80%) of students satisfied ('satisfactory' or higher) with the academic performance and ambiance of the institution. Remedial actions will be initiated if feedback falls below this established benchmark. Similarly, measures will be taken if responses to open-ended questions indicate significant or serious concerns (expressed by over 20% of the population) or were of a serious nature to warrant an action.

These action benchmarks, along with suitable actions, provide a comprehensive approach to address any shortcomings in the feedback parameters and continually enhance the quality of education, infrastructure, and student satisfaction across all the parameters.

Note: In the Academic Year 2022-23, the survey included 5 questions, providing the opportunity to rank options based on satisfaction using a numerical scale: 1 - Not Satisfactory, 2 - Average, 3 - Satisfactory, 4 - Good, and 5 – Excellent.

Corresponding action benchmark: Attaining 80% satisfaction, which is defined as the selection of a rating at 'Satisfactory' or higher, or achieving a score of 3 or above on a scale ranging from 1 to 5, as used in the Academic Year 2022-23 survey with 5 questions.

The feedback is obtained yearly from various stakeholders and taken into consideration for corrective actions to be made by the committee.


At the end of Semester the feedback forms are distributed among the concerned stake holders
