- The Memorandum of understanding (MoU) as outlined in this document is not intended to be a legally binding document. Rather, it is meant to describe the nature and collaborative intentions of the PARTIES to suggest guidelines for cooperation. Nothing, therefore, shall diminish the full autonomy of either party, or any constraints be imposed by either party upon each other, and nothing in this Agreement shall be deemed to create a partnership, joint venture, or agency relationship between the parties.
- 5.2 The Memorandum of Understanding or any part thereof may be amended at any time during its tenure only by consent in writing of the parties.

- Joint conferences and workshops;
- Faculty and students exchange programs for academic and non-academic activities;
- Team taught courses, including online courses; and
- Mutual isits by faculty, professional staff, and students.

The parties anticipate that a number of these initiatives will occur during the period of this MOU. However, neither party is obligated to agree to any minimum number of activities, nor is this MOU intended to preclude either party from entering into similar agreements with other institutions.

This MOU shall be identified as the parent document of any program agreement executed between the parties. Further agreements concerning any program shall provide details concerning the specific commitments made by each party and shall not become effective until they have been reduced to writing, executed by the duly authorized representatives of the parties.

The primary contacts for this MOU are Principal for Indira Priyadarshini Government Degree College and Principal for Sarojini Naidu Vanita Maha Vidyalaya. As previously noted, the parties shall enter into specific written agreements whenever appropriate to clarify and define the nature, extent, and terms of operation for the proposed collaborations, including intellectual property ownership and funding issues. agreement entered into by these two institutions will require the approval of appropriate officers from each institution.

#### Tenure and Termination

This MoU will take effect from the date it is signed by representatives of the two institutions. It will remain valid for five years, and may be continued thereafter after suitable review and agreement. 





Whereas the First Party is a Private Intermediate & Degree College in the state of Telangana. And that it intends to encourage vocational training among women to help them learn skills that could be useful in advancing their career and as a tool to attain employment / self-sufficiency in life. that it recognizes that courses offered under the Second Party are useful skills to be imparted to ladies to help them in personal grooming and as a viable employment option.



disclosure or access, in particular where the processing involves the transmission of data over a network, and against all other unlawful forms of processing.

- 'Personal Data' Breach" means a breach of security leading to the accidental or unlawful destruction, loss, alteration, unauthorized disclosure of, or access to personal data transmitted, stored or otherwise processed.
- vII. 'Processing' or any other derivative thereof, means any operation or set of operations performed upon PI, whether or not by automatic means; such as collection, recording, organization, structuring, storage, adaptation or alteration, consultation, use, disclosure by transmission, dissemination or otherwise making available, alignment or combination, restriction, blocking, erasure or destruction.




