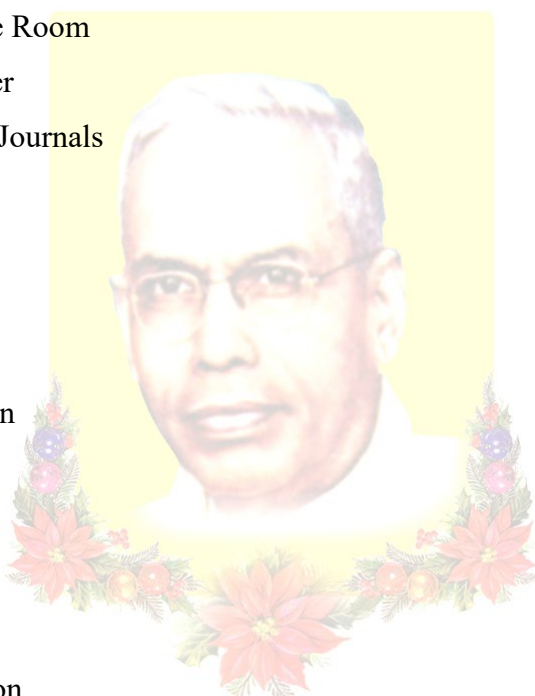

History of Library:

The department of Library and Information Science aims at igniting and empowering the young minds to face the burgeoning challenges. Making a humble beginning way back in the year 1995, the Department caters to academic and research needs of the students and faculty and facilitates independent learning.

At Present library has 8655 books, 6 International Journals, 18 National Journals and 3 periodicals. Five different News Papers caters to the day-to-day information of the users.

Previously the MBA Library was clubbed with the PG Library. During this period Ms. Krishanaveni, M.com, MLISc was the P.G librarian in 1998-2008. In the year 2006 the MBA Library has been shifted to the third floor, the MBA Block, to cater the growing requirements of the MBA students.

In the year 2008 Ms.G.Y.Madhavi, MA MLISc, has taken over the charge as Librarian.

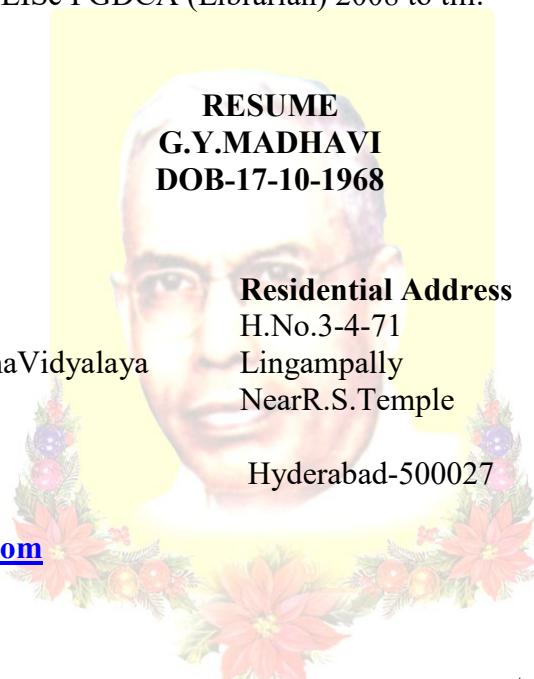

At present, the total numbers of books in MBA library are 8598. Every year we are subscribing more than 25 International and National Journals and Magazines.

Reading Room: The reading section is spacious, well-furnished and ventilated, with 6 reading tables, 40 chairs and 2 magazine display racks. One with a capacity of 25 cabinets with the provision to store previous issues, the other one is the display rack. The reference section has 13 bookracks, stock section consisting of 44 bookracks.



Circulation Counter:

The circulation counter, a system with the entire data of accessioned books, is used to issue/return/renewal the books.

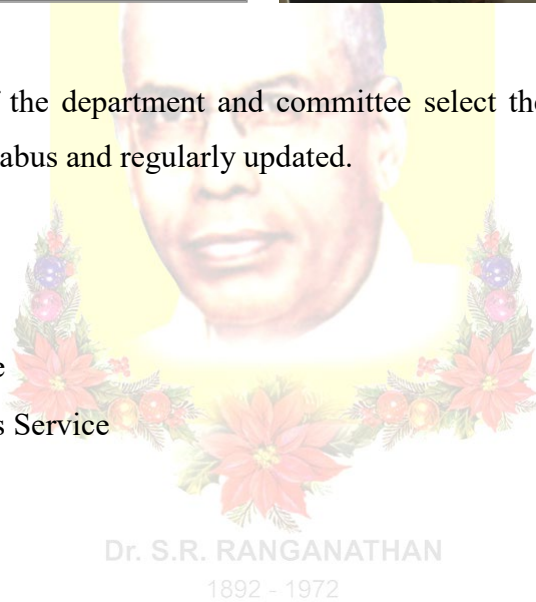
The college has a varied collection of valuable books of not curriculum but also of general interest and of perennial literacy value. The total number of books in the MBA library (accessioned) is 8598. The library has been subscribing 25 International and National Journals and Periodicals, magazines and 5 News Papers.

Reference Section

We have 2278 volumes of reference books, which are arranged in 13 separate racks. A part from the reference books pertaining to the curriculum, Encyclopedias, Dictionaries (general and subjects), and Atlases Maps are also available in the reference section.



Reading Section

The Reading section is well furnished with 6 reading tables with a seating capacity of 40. About 25 periodicals and magazines and six newspapers in English, are provided.



Technical Services

The books in the library are classified as per the Dewey decimal classification schedule of 21st edition. The classification to cataloguing is in progress.

Library Automation

Acting like a backbone for the generation of new knowledge, the Library has been automated using Integrated Library Management System NEWGENLIB Software and provides Online Public Access Catalogue facility through LAN. Internet facilities are provided for Online Access to Open Resources.

Issue of Books

Each student can borrow 7 books at a time, which can be retained for fifteen days. On an average about 20 students visit the library every day for issue and also the books of reference section.



Intra Library Loan

Intra library loan facility is there between the U.G. P.G, MBA and library within the college.

Sources of Funds

Funds required for the purchase of books and journals are procured from the following sources.

- Student's special fee Account

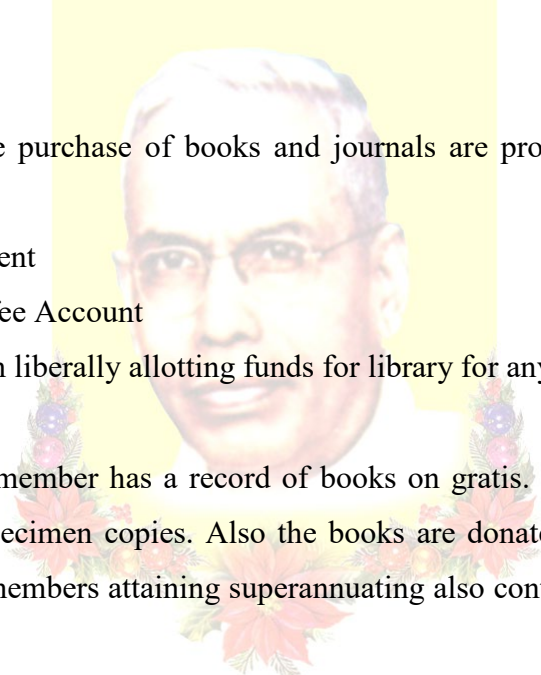
The management has been liberally allotting funds for library for any additional requirements.

Almost every faculty member has a record of books on gratis. Some books are collected from the publishers as specimen copies. Also the books are donated from students, parents, and friends. The faculty members attaining superannuating also contribute from their personal collections.

Students Orientation:

Every year the Librarians conducts an Orientation Programme to the fresher's about the library facility, services, issues & returns etc. This is also done by the Lecturers to their respective students. This paves the way for the new students to understand the library transactions and also at the same time makes them familiar to their subject books. A brief introduction of the journals and their uses like the current trends in their subjects, job news, information of the current news and events is also given to the students.

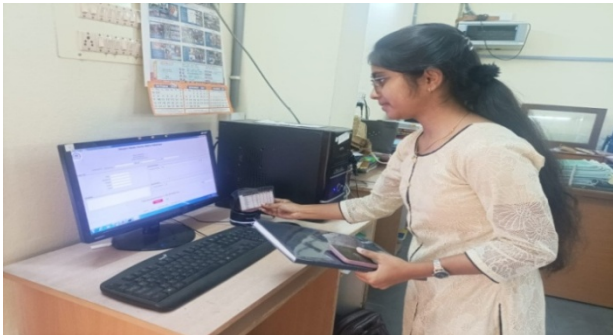


Project Reports:

The project reports which are submitted by the M.B.A Students are preserved in the library for the reference of the fresh students. Presently, the library possesses the reports submitted of students.

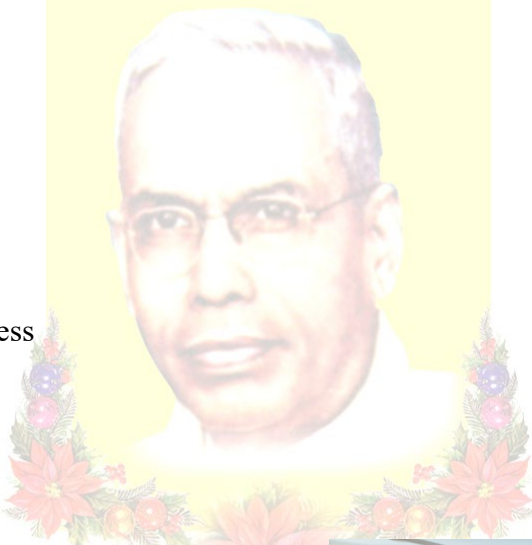

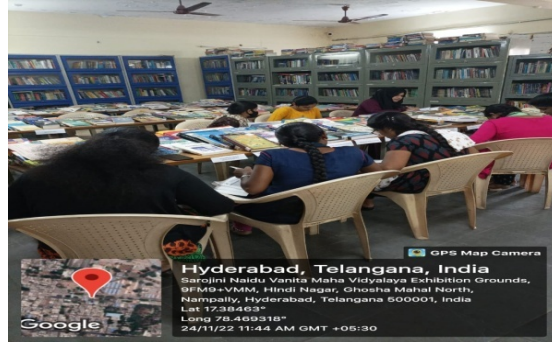
