## Department of English - A Brief History

English being a mandatory subject for all course offered by the college, the Department of English has been in existence right from the time of the College's inception. The growth and development of the department and the College has therefore been parallel. Like the college, the department evolved from fledgling beginning to its present stature as one of the largest departments with strength of fifteen members on its faculty.

The department began literally as a one-man show in 1962 with Mr. Lingam as its founder-lecturer who served for two years and paved the way for an all-women work force to take charge of the department. From then on Ms. Rankin Maeckinon took over as head who was married to an Irish gentleman and it is perhaps a matter of happy coincidence that the department burgeoned with appropriate roots; Dr. Mrs. Sudha Ranganathan who joined the department in 1966 took over from Ms. Maeckinon as Head in 1975 and continued till her retirement in 1986. A Postgraduate from the hallowed Presidency College, Madras; Ms. Ranganathan is fondly remembered for her immense erudition, cultured elegance and razor-sharp wit

**Dr.Ranganathan** had a worthy deputy in **Dr.Polly N.Chenoy**. She was an erudite, charming and sophisticated lady, who received her doctoral degree from The University of Utah, USA. She left the department to join Osmania University as Reader in 1985. **Ms.Vimala G.Rao** was another distinguished member of the department at this time, well known for her scholarship, humour and elegance .She unfortunately had to resign from service in 1973, due to her husband's transfer to Bangalore.

It was during this period that the department embarked on maximum expansion, both in terms of the increase in the number of faculty as well as students. Optional English now attracted the best students and became one of the most sought-after subjects.

The mantle of heading the department was taken on in 1986 by Dr. Shanta Subba Rao reputed as much of her moorings in spirituality as for her scholarly pursuits in Sanskrit and Oriental and Occidental philosophies. Her Ph.D. thesis on a comparative study of fables of Aesop and parables of Jesus Christ, Sri Ramakrishna Paramahansa and Kahlil Gibran, bears testimony to her eclectic taste.

**Dr.Rao** served the institution in various capacities –Vice-Principal (Arts) and as a staff representative of the Governing Body of the Management Committee of the college .She opted for voluntary retirement from the service in 2003 after putting in 33 years of service despite being a frontrunner for the Principal's post to concentrate full time on her work as an active member /office bearer of the Sivananda Ashram, Hrishikesh and various other organizations she is connected.

**Dr.Subba Rao** was ably assisted in her duties by the other members of the department some of whom currently hold key posts in college ;others who are presently in the faculty and a retired member –Ms. Bhavani Sastry. A gentle and soft-spoken lady, Ms. Sastry is best remembered for her love for music and Telugu literature as much as for acumen in academic

affairs. She retired from service in 1994. Among those who held key posts is Dr. Vasundhara Augamiyah who was the Vice-principal (Arts) & retired as Principal in March 2007. Earlier she served as Head of the Department and as the Director of Post-graduate studies. As an active and articulate member of the department, Dr. Augamiyah has been instrumental in setting up the NSS of the college way back in 1976, the student's counseling centre in 1995 and a crèche in 2004. It is to her credit that she became the first in-service Reader of the Department in 1987.

A contemporary of hers, Ms. Shamima Patel has been the Director of Post-Graduate Studies and a member of the Governing Body of the Management Committee from 2001 to 2006. Another contemporary of hers Prof. Veena Noble Dass was appointed as Vice-Chancellor of Sri Padmavathi Mahila Viswavidyalayam, Tirupathi. Prof. Dass started her career at Vanita and worked from 1973 to 1997 when she was selected as professor of English at Sri Padmavathi Mahila Viswavidyalayam, Tirupathi.

The trio played a vital role in setting up the Post-Graduate Department of English which incidentally is the first P.G Department in the College. Playing equally vital and significant roles in various capacities are Ms. Thelma Muire and Ms. Pratima Shah. Ms. Muire – a drama expert and theatre buff, highly respected and conscientious teacher whose eloquence and wit both inside and outside the classroom are cherished by the students and staff alike. Ms. Muire was on the Editorial Board of the Common Core Syllabus Committee, A.P. She opted for voluntary retirement from service in 2003 after serving the institution for 29 years.

**Ms. Pratima Shah**, the next Head of the Department is singular in holding a Master's Degree in Linguistics besides English. In addition, she holds a Post-Graduate Diploma in teaching of English from the Central Institute of English and Foreign Languages which fortifies her reputation as a Grammar expert. Another member with a penchant for grammar was Dr. Leela Rao, whose career at Vanitha was in two stints. Her predilection for learning took her away from teaching to improve her qualifications. She was also oriented towards social service as an active member of the Sri Satya Sai Organization, Puttaparthi, Ananthapur Dist A.P and is presently staying there. Another member in the faculty Ms. Ramola Naidu, a silent meticulous worker, thanks to whom our registers and records are neatly and presentably maintained. Her quiet wit and enigmatic smile help to lighten many stressful moments and keep the atmosphere cheerful. She has shouldered many responsible positions both in the department and college as the Chief Editor of College Magazine, Student Advisor, Staff Secretary and has acquitted herself creditably in whatever work assigned to her. She headed the department in 2007 then became the P.G Director, Vice Principal and retired as Principal of the college in Jan 2010.

**Dr. B. Sandhya:** Former Principal, P.G. Director was a member of the Board of Studies (English) Osmania University. attended the Departmental Conference at the Dept. of English, Arts College, O.U. attended the BOS Meeting on 25-3-13 at O.U. co-ordinator for English Essay Writing Competition conducted by Hyderabad Metro Rail. She contributed as a course writer for M.A. Distance Education. She was also the Resource Person for U.G.C. National Seminar on "Strategies of Teaching English" at City College, Hyderabad and was the organizing Secretary for Sarojini Naidu Poetry Fest and a member of Board of Studies English (U.G) O.U. She also judged the Elocution Competitions held at Kamala Nehru Polytechnic College, Hyderabad.

**Dr. Sudha, Associate Professor, Former Head:** - She has completed a Minor Research

This fact sheet highlights those activities and achievements that have gone on to become benchmarks and remain as milestones in the history of the department and the college as well.

Even as classroom teachers has major share in the departmental duties/functions, the department's assistance, contribution and involvement percolates through a spate of activities that extend beyond the classroom.

It is Customary every year for members of the department to double up as student's adviser, Chief Editor of College Magazine and staff secretary. As student's adviser one member each year takes charge of all students' activities. This includes conduct of literary and cultural fests, putting up the cultural programme for the college day and organizing the fresher's and farewell party for students.

As Chief Editor of the college Magazine "VANITA" the staff members of the department collect, compile, proof reads articles and publishes the magazines on behalf of the college yearly. Besides chronicling the present, the magazine provides the students and staff with a platform to air their creative and critical talents and opinions in myriad ways in English, Hindi, Telugu, Urdu, Sanskrit and Arabic. "VANITA" is well received by the staff and students and the reading public at large. The magazine also gives parents a glimpse of how the college functions and the opportunities that are provided to students. As staff secretary, the member represents the staff and oversees the extra-mural interests of the staff like arranging for farewell parties for retired staff members, educational tours and picnics for the staff and acting as a liaison officer between the principal/Management and staff in general.

The department has also been consistently involved in the academic activities of Osmania University. It is a matter of pride for the department that Dr. Polly N. Chenoy, Dr. Shanta Subba Rao, Dr. Sunitha Sharma, Ms. Thelma Muire and Dr. Vasundhara Augamiyha have done us proud by being on the editorial board of the common core Syllabus Committee A.P., for both U.G. & P.G. Other members of the department have also contributed as paper setters for general and optional English and Moderators at the time of evaluation in Osmania University. Ms. Shamima Patel & Ms. Ranjana Deshpande have been on the panel of lecturers for the center for Distance Education, Osmania University. Ms. Patel even co-authored a textbook for the said center.

Dr. Vasundhara Augamiyah & Ms. Shamima Patel were content generators and presenters of teaching lessons for the K.U Band, which airs lessons based on the common core syllabus of the Universities in Andhra Pradesh.

Dr. B. Sandhya and Dr. B. Sudha are course writers for B.A.ML for P.G.R.R.C.D.E. Osmania University.

Dr. B. Sandhya has written the instruction material for B.A II Modern language for P.G.R.R.C.D.E. Osmania University.

Dr. B. Sudha has written the instruction material for B.A.III Modern Language for P.G.R.R.C.D.E. Osmania University.

Coming to our own college, we have had several members over the years discharging important administrative duties. Dr. Shanta Subba Rao was the Vice-Principal (Arts) and then Dr. Vasundhara Augamiyah held the post who later became the Principal of the college and retired. Dr. Shanta Subba Rao was the staff representative on the Governing Body of the college Management Committee and Ms. Shamima Patel also had done the honors besides being the P.G. Director, Vice-Principal and Principal.

Mrs. Ramola Naidu discharged her duties as Head of the Department, P.G. Director, Vice-Principal and retired as Principal. After her Dr. Sandhya is presently holding the post of P.G. Director and the mantle of heading the Department fell on Dr. B. Sudha who is currently the HOD.

Several members of the department have gone on promotion to other institutions and Universities, Dr. Sudha Ranganathan went on lien to work as the first Principal of Padmavathi Mahila Kalashala at Hyderabad for a one-and-half year stint. Dr. Polly N. Chenoy joined Osmania University as Reader in 1985.

Prof. Veena Noble Das who started her career at Vanita in 1973, worked till 1997 when she was appointed as Professor at Sri Padmavathi Mahila Viswavidyalaya, Tirupathi. She worked as Dean, School of Humanities and Management in the same University and became its Vice-chancellor.

It was under Prof. Dass' aegis as secretary of the All India Common Wealth Association that the Sixth International Common Wealth Studies Conference was hosted by the Department of English from 4-6<sup>th</sup> Oct. 1993. It was also in this year that Prof. Dass' received the State Best Teachers' Award. The inspiration and initiative to start P.G. Studies in Vanita Maha Vidyalaya also came from the Department of English. Dr. Augamiyah worked both ends of the spectrum –the college management and Osmania university to start P.G. studies in M.A (Eng) and M.Com. The Post-graduate department of English has earned respect as one of the best Departments of English at Osmania University with a track record of academic excellence. Azra Hussain a student of M.A. 1992-94 batch stood second at the O.U public Examination and most of the students have been well employed and some have started their own institutions.

B. Sukanya of 2007-09 batch received O.G.A Gold medal for General Proficiency for topping the Examination.

Shirley of 2008-10 batches received the Osmania Graduates Association's Gold medal.

Mere academic excellence is not the only reason for the department's well –sustained performance. Constant updating of knowledge and exposure to latest trends and techniques in the subject widen the scope of the academic offerings of the department. To this end, in-service workshops and seminars are conducted regularly for the staff. They are also encouraged to participate in Refresher and Orientation courses, present and publish papers and raise their level of research activity. Extension lectures by experts from Osmania University, the University of Hyderabad and the Central Institute of English Foreign Languages also comprise important elements of the departmental culture.

The department also holds individual and institutional membership to prestigious libraries

like the IACIS, British Library, Central Library, State Library, the libraries of Osmania University and the CIEFL. The department also undertakes the selection and purchase of books for the college library. An educational tour is organized in this regard every alternate year wherein P.G. Students are taken to the world book fair at the Pragathi Maidan in New Delhi.

Several members of the department have also been actively involved in the production and staging of plays by frontline dramatists. Dr. Polly N. Chenoy and Ms. Thelma Muire have been longstanding members of the Dramatic Circle of Hyderabad. They are also members of the Poetry Society of Hyderabad. Currently Dr. Augamiyah, Ms. Patel, Ms. Ranjana, Ms. Jayasree and Mrs. Rajitha are on its rolls.

The department oversees the admission to Inter I (CEC) and Degree (Arts) Courses every year and several members are drawn for examination duties like the controller of exams in college and deputed as Sitting / Flying Squad members for the University exams. They have also rendered services for Janmabhoomi Programmes, General Elections and Census duties.

On the cultural and extra-curricular fronts too, the role of the department has been equally widespread and laudatory. The department anchors both formal and informal programmes for the College and Sport Day Celebrations. This facility is also extended to other departments while conducting their valedictory and felicitation functions. The annual diary of literary and cultural events is also maintained by the Department.

The college celebrated the birth centenary of Sarojini Naidu in 1987 with pomp and gaiety. Twenty-six poems of the poet were set to music and dance, choreographed by the department. The event is recalled with gusto even to this day. This year too we have celebrated Sarojini Naidu Birth Anniversary by enacting and reciting her poems by the students of M.A English.

The department also extends its support to other areas like social service and counseling. Dr. Vasundhara Augamayah initiated the NSS in College in 1976 and since then the unit has been nurtured to be recognized as one of the best among the affiliated and constituent college units of Osmania University.

Dr. Augamayah was also instrumental in setting up the Students' Counseling Center to fulfill the ever-increasing need of the student's community for information regarding educational and career opportunities, general information and emotional support. This widens the role of an educational institution by extending it beyond academic instruction and aiming at a holistic, integrated development of students that helps them become well trained, groomed, informed and poised individuals well prepared to face life once out of the portals of college.

Dr. Augamiyah has also been the founder-member of "**Amanshanti**" a damage control organization for peace, which extends its services in times like communal riots and anti-social activities. She has been on the governing body of AWARE, an NGO working in tribal areas and HCHW, an NGO run by trained social workers who fight for the dignity and protection from exploitation of street children.

Dr. Vasundhara Augamiyah got to fulfill Dr. Sudha Ranganathan's dream of starting a crèche for the children of the teaching and non-teaching staff by persuading and convincing the Chairman and Secretary and Members of the Management of the increased efficiency of the staff, once provision is made for the care of their children. Kudos to the sensitivity of the

Management in acknowledging teachers' professional ability of validating their motherhood.

The department has over the years distinguished itself setting in achieving high standards of academic excellence, winning laurels individually and collectively and performing variegated functions in college life in a sustained manner. Comprising dynamic, dashing and diligent staff with different styles and opinions, interest and ambitions, the department yet believes in a common vision of exploring, evaluating and inculcating new trends and techniques in its function. Powered by this contemporaneity, the department looks forward to a significant future that looks back to the past with pride while relishing the achievements of the present.
