A Brief Profile

Sarojini Naidu Vanita Maha Vidyalaya established in the year 1962 by the Osmania Graduates' Association and the Exhibition Society is one of the largest Women's College in the country. Spread over 3.8 acres in the sprawling Exhibition Grounds, the college is affiliated to Osmania University and offers Intermediate, Undergraduate and Postgraduate courses, including Masters in Business Management.

The college with good infrastructure, spacious classrooms with glass boards, digital classrooms, adequate rest rooms and mineral water plant caters to the needs of around 3300 students. The spacious laboratories with modern apparatus and equipment, books in three separate libraries for U.G., P.G., and M.B.A provide an advanced learning experience for students. The college has an auditorium with 572 seating capacity named after the founder member of OGA, Sri Shankerji, for seminars, conferences, orientation programmes, various competitions and cultural programmes of the college and also OGA.

The college Hostel accommodates 580 inmates from neighbouring districts.

The college has over 421 systems. There are separate Computer Labs for Commerce, Science, English and M.B.A Departments. All the Departments are provided with computers, for research and advancement of the faculty with Internet facility.

A well-equipped Sports Department facilitates coaching in Indoor and outdoor games, Martial Arts, Skating, Aerobics, Yoga and Archery.

The NCC Unit has a student intake of 160 cadets. There has been a consistent student representation in the Thal Sainik Camp and Republic Day Parade at New Delhi. The College has three units of NSS (National Service Scheme) with an enrolment of 300 volunteers.

Vanita has a Counselling Centre and a Placement Cell. The Placement Cell imparts training in soft skills and communication skills to enhance the employable capabilities of the students. Students have been placed in various MNCs like WIPRO, INFOSYS, GENPACT, TRANSDYNE, MEDWRITE etc.,. Apart from this, the Banking Services and Civil Services coaching centre helps the students to make career choices.

The Sangeet Vanita, well equipped with Veenas and Sitars, conducts classes in vocal and instrumental music. Dance classes are also conducted for the interested students. NIPUNI – the Skill Development Centre facilitates the students in learning different skills, thus enhancing the self-employment opportunities.

Sarojini Naidu Vanita Maha Vidyalaya provides academic and other opportunities for the holistic development of the students with the constant support, guidance and encouragement from the Management.

1. Rules of Admission

- a. Admission to all classes will be strictly on the basis of merit and reservation.
- b. No Donation for admission is accepted.
- c. Candidates are expected to preserve the counterfoil of the fee challan and produce it at the time of admission.

2. Reservation of seats:

- a) 15%, 6% and 25% of seats will be reserved for Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Backward Classes respectively, subject to the production of Caste Certificate duly signed by competent authorities, at the time of registration.
- b) Seats are reserved for physically handicapped candidates and the children of Exservicemen and Defence Personnel residing in the State. Seats are also reserved for the candidates with merit in Sports, NCC and Extra Curricular Activities, subject to the production of relevant certificates.

3. Copies of Certificates to be enclosed with the application for admission to UG and PG Courses.

- a) A certified copy of Memorandum of Marks of the qualifying examination.
- b) A certified copy of Transfer Certificate (T.C.) from the School or College where the candidate has studied previously.
- c) Migration Certificate in case of students coming from Boards other than the Board of Intermediate Education, Telangana State.
- d) Candidates coming from other States should give a declaration, prior to their admission to the course, to the effect that no disciplinary action was taken against them by the concerned University or Board.
- e) In the case of students belonging to Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribe, Backward Classes, EBC's and Minorites, Caste and Income Certificates are to be submitted in the prescribed proforma.
- f) At the time of admission, the candidate has to submit the following original certificates 1)T.C 2) Memorandum of marks 3) Caste Certificate 4) Income Certificate 5) Aadhar Certificate

4. Rules of Attendance

- a. Students are required to attend at least 75% of the lecturers in each subject in each Semester for UG & PG Programmes
- b. If a candidate fails to secure 75% attendance, the college has the authority to withhold the examination form and prevent the student from appearing for the University Examination.
- c. No Student will be allowed to abstain herself from the college without leave, for which an application must be submitted on the first day of their return to the college. Application for leave on grounds of ill-health must be accompanied by a Medical Certificate.
- d. Only those students who put in 75% attendance are eligible to draw scholarship.

5. Tests and Examinations

- I. Attendance for tests and internal examinations is compulsory
- 2. Quarterly exams shall beheld in the month of September/October
- 3. Pre-final exams shall be held in the month of January/February
- 4. Intermediate examinations shall be as perthe schedule of the BIE
- 5. PG examinations shall be as perthe schedule of the Osmania University

6. Code of Conduct

- a. Punctuality in attending lectures should be strictly observed. Late comers will lose their attendance.
- b. Students are expected to be neat and clean. Their dress must be simple and must confirm to the standards of modesty maintained by the Institution.
- c. Students must be polite and use decent language
- d. Students are not allowed to see any visitors during the college hours.
- e. Students are advised to read the notices displayed on the notice board.
- f. Students are not allowed to use cell phones in the campus. Violation of the rules is liable for disciplinary action

7. Fees once paid will not be refunded.

8. Bus Pass Facility

Students can avail the bus pass facility as the college is an aided institution. The college is well connected to the MMTS, RTC bus service and is covered under the Hyderabad Metro Rail scheme with a station at Gandhi Bhavan.

9. Scholarship / Student Aid Fund

- I. As per the rules of the Central and State Governments, Scholarship is available to the SC, ST, BC, Minority and EBC students.
- 2. The Economically Backward Students who are not eligible for any other scholarship, are eligible to receive financial assistance from the college under the 'Vanita Vidya Sahakaram' and 'Students Aid Fund'.

Free EAPCET and NEET Coaching

Eligibility Criteria For Intermediate Admissions

- 1. Candidates must have passed the 10th class examination of Telangana State (SSC) or any other examination recognised as equivalent, by the Board of Intermediate Education of Telangana State.
- 2. The Candidates who have passed 10th class examination in other than English Medium are eligible for English Medium if they have secured more than 40% marks in General English in 10th class examination.
- 3. Candidates who have passed 10th class examination with Domestic Science are not eligible for Science group.
- 4. Candidates who have passed 10th class exam from (ICSE or CBSE etc.) other than Telangana State SSC Board must submit eligibility certificate issued by Board of Intermediate Education, Telangana at the time of admission.
- 5. Candidates who have passed SSC with Telugu Medium are exempted from 40% marks criteria in General English for vocational courses.

ATTENDANCE

- 1. STUDENTS ARE REQUIRED TO HAVE 75% ATTENDANCE IN EVERY SUBJECT.
- 2. The examination forms of only such candidates will be forwarded to the BIE who have put in atleast 75% of the attendance before the date of sending the examination forms.
- 3. If a candidate fails to secure 75% attendance, the college has the authority to withhold the examination form and prevent the student from appearing for the Intermediate Examination.
- 4. For the purpose of counting the percentage of attendance the date of commencement of the classes shall be taken into account and not the date of admission of the candidate.
- 5. 10% Medical Leave will be calculated only for those students who produce appropriate Medical Certificate on the day they resume classes.
- 6. NSS, NCC Camps and Sports events will qualify for full attendance during the period of the camps and events only when supporting and relevant certificates are submitted.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

CONDUCT OF STUDENT

- 1. College gates will be closed from 10.00 AM to 3.30 PM. Late comers will not be allowed into the college after 10.00 AM
- 2. Punctuality in attending lectures should be strictly observed. Late comers shall lose their attendance for the lecture for which they are late.
- 3. Students should not loiter in the college grounds or make noise during working hours.

 During free periods they should work silently in the library.
- 4. Students are advised to see the Notice Board, Signage Boards every day.
- 5. Students are responsible for their belongings in the college premises.
- 6. Use of mobile phones is strictly prohibited.

FOR THE PARENT OR GUARDIAN

- 1. Parents/Guardians can meet the Principal and Vice-Principals between 3.00 PM to 4.00 PM.
- 2. Faculty members shall be available for interaction on all working days after 2.00 PM.
- 3. Parents and Guardians are requested to participate in the Parent-Teacher meeting which shall be held in the last week of September and November

GRIEVANCE REDRESSAL CELL

- 1. To resolve any issue of the students, there is a Grievance Redressal Cell headed by the Principal and other members.
- 2. Suggestion/Complaint boxes are placed at various places where students can drop complaints which shall be resolved by the Cell
- 3. Action shall be taken by the Cell based on the Feedback given by Students.

ANTI-RAGGING CELL

- 1. Ragging is strictly Prohibited in the college
- Punishment according to Anti-Ragging Act shall be given to students involved in any ragging activity
- 3. The Anti-Ragging Squad and the Anti-Ragging Committee is formed in accordance with the directives issued by the State Government, Osmania University and AICTE rules.

FACILITIES ON CAMPUS

The college has a sprawling campus of 3.8 acres with spacious classrooms, E-Classroom well equipped laboratories with modern apparatus. Computer labs with modern systems, English language lab, Commerce Computer Lab for Tally, E-commerce programmes. Faculty members make use of modern teaching methods and make PPT and LCD presentations.

LIBRARY

The college has a collection of over 65,000 books in three separate libraries for UG, PG and MBA. The libraries subscribe for various journals, magazines and newspapers. The library under the n-list and j-gate Programme has open access system to the online journals and e-books.





AUDITORIUM

The college has a large two-tier auditorium with a 600 seating capacity named after the founder member of the OGA Shri.Shankarji, widely used for seminars, conferences, orientation programmes, various competitions and cultural programmes of the college, the OGA and even government organizations.

SPORTS AND GAMES

The four acre campus provides excellent scope for fostering a keen interest in both indoor and outdoor sports. Coaching is provided in Yoga, Aerobics, Martial Arts like Judo, Karate and Twai Kon Do. Our students are encouraged to participate in Intervarsity, State, National and International championships and they have brought many laurels and awards to the college.

NCC

NCC with its Motto 'Unity and Discipline' has a great role in the Personality Development of the students and we, at Vanita lay a great emphasis on student participation in NCC. The NCC



unit attached to 1 (A) Girls battalion, has a student in take of 200 cadets and many of our cadets pass the 'B' and 'C' certificate exam conducted by the Ministry of Defense. The Government gives numerous incentives to outstanding cadets like reservation of seats in education, employment, army recruitment and financial assistance through scholarships.

NSS

National Service Scheme with its Motto 'NOT ME BUT YOU', provides an opportunity to the students to participate in community service. There are 3 units of NSS with 300 volunteers. NSS volunteers who put in 240 hours of service and attend two special camps are eligible for merit certificate of the Osmania University which enables them to get preference in admission for higher education. Our NSS Programme Officer Dr.CH. Padma received the prestigious

I. NIPUNI

The Skill Development Centre offers Certificate Courses in various skills like Beautician, Tailoring, Fashion Designing, MS Office, Fabric Painting, etc. Nipuni has an MOU with Setwin, a Government of Telangana organisation. Students apart from academics can equip themselves with an additional skill.

- 2. BANKING AND CIVIL SERVICES COACHING: Students aspiring for employment opportunities in Banking sector can avail Banking Services Coaching. Civil Services Coaching in the college offers excellent opportunities for recruitment to Services like IAS, IPS at the Central level and Group I and Group II Services at the State Level.
- 3. COMPUTER CENTRE WITH INTERNET FACILITY: Internet Facility is provided to the students through the computer centre where they can access the latest information and use it for preparation of study material.
- **4. HOSTEL:** Hostel accommodation is available to students from outside the city. Our hostel can accommodate 560 students. The hostel has Mineral Water Plant, Solar Water Heating system, Landry washing machine, Gym, Recreation facilities, Library and Computer facility with internet.
- **5. MENTORING :** Mentoring of students by their concerned class teachers helps in interaction at a personal level to understand the needs and talent of every student and guide them in their endeavours.
- 6. COUNSELLING: Student Counseling Centre provides career and personal counseling keeping in mind the growing complexities in the society and the problems faced by the Youth. Awareness lectures on various issues are organized. It also conducts short term courses.
- 7. EXTRA AND CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES: Students can participate in various literary and cultural activities and showcase their talent. Opportunities are provided to participate in inter-class, inter-collegiate competitions at various levels and win prizes.
- **8. ALUMNAE ASSOCIATION:** Being out of sight is not being out of mind. The alumnae association provides an opportunity of reunion for all its old students. Many of our alumnae have made the institution proud by their positions in the society.

9. SANGEET VANITA

Students interested in learning music and dance can avail the opportunity provided by Sangeet Vanita which offers coaching in Classical, Semi-Classical, Vocal and Instrumental.

- 10. PLACEMENT CELL: Placement cell caters to the employment requirements of the UG and PG students. Training in Communication Skills and Soft Skills is provided to enhance the employable capabilities of the students. On Campus and Off Campus interviews are organized and many of our students find placements in companies like WIPRO, INFOSYS, GENPACT, TRANSDYNE etc.

TELANGANA STATE PROHIBITION OF RAGGING ACT, 1997

SALIENT FEATURES

Ragging means doing an act which causes or is likely to cause insult or annoyance or fear or apprehension or threat or intimidation or outrage of modesty or injury to a student.

No.	NATURE OF RAGGING	PUNISHMENT
1.	Teasing, Embarrassing and Humiliating	Imprisonment upto 6 months Or fine upto Rs.1000/- or both.
2.	Assaulting or Using Criminal Force or Criminal intimidation	Imprisonment upto 1 year Or fine upto Rs.2000/- or both.
3.	Wrongfully restraining or confining or causing hurt	Imprisonment upto 2 years Or fine upto Rs.5000/- or both.
4.	Causing grievous hurt, kidnapping or rape or committing unnatural offence	Imprisonment upto 5 years Or fine upto Rs.10000/- or both.
5.	Causing death or abetting suicide	Imprisonment upto 10 years Or fine upto Rs.5000/- or both.

NOTE:

- 1. A student convicted of any of the above offences will be expelled from the college.
- 2. A student imprisoned for more than 6 month for any of the above offences will note be admitted in any other college.
- 3. A student against whom there is prima facie evidence of ragging in any form will be suspended from the college immediately.
- 4. In case of the students who are involved in ragging, there shall be an embossment on his marks cards and other academic certificates in bold letters which cannot be obliterated that he had indulged in ragging and had conducted himself in a manner unbecoming of student.
